



ADOPT-A-TREE PROGRAM

Here's your opportunity to be part of an exciting city beautification program in the development of an urban forest!

The City of Whitefish has created an ADOPT-A-TREE program for the purpose of enhancing the tree inventory within our community. The program is designed to increase the number of trees along the right-of way of city streets. The program offers a unique collaboration between the home owner and the City of Whitefish, where limited funds are available for the purchase and placement of a tree, and the home owner agrees to provide proper irrigation for the first 3 years of the life of the tree. The City will provide irrigation collars or tubes in an effort to minimize the efforts in performing this task and to maximize the use of the water resource.

Should you wish to participate in the Adopt-A-Tree Program, please complete the enclosed application form and return to the City of Whitefish Parks and Recreation Department for review and consideration. Each property will have special circumstances that we need to be taken into account as to opportunities to plant, locations, limitations, proper tree species and size, etc. Not all properties will be eligible to participate in the Adopt-A-Tree Program due to a number of factors. However, we would certainly encourage all interested individuals to submit an application for consideration.

Once an application is submitted City of Whitefish staff will review the property and determine eligibility and suggest a number of location options along with the type of tree that would be acceptable for that property. Some situations will dictate that only one type of tree may be acceptable for that location, while other locations may have a number of tree species to select. Once eligibility is determined the application will be returned to the homeowner for their approval prior to the purchase and planting of the tree. Funding is limited; therefore early application is encouraged in determining a priority list.
