Ballot Tracking is available for Federal Primary and General elections only. To track a ballot in another election, [contact your county election office](#).

For the November 2020 General Election, absentee ballots will be sent out on October 9, 2020. For those counties that choose to have a mail ballot election, ballots will be sent out to all active registered voters in that county on October 9, 2020. Voters who are registered as absent military or overseas citizens are sent ballots earlier, at least 45 days before the election.

The ballot status will be updated when ballots are sent. For UOCAVA voters that will be September 18, 2020. For all others that will be October 9, 2020.


